Tentative Plan for our Experience

Monday, March 23, 2026

Our time together begins with prayer, social time, and dinner at Catholic Theological Union (CTU). We'll meet one another, review the plan for the days ahead and address any questions.

Tuesday, March 24, 2026

We begin the day with breakfast and Mass at CTU, followed by panel discussions and group reflection on the immigration crisis in the United States. After lunch, we head to the New Life Center to participate in various service activities. We will join the community at the Center for dinner and return to CTU for shared reflection and closing prayer.

Wednesday, March 25, 2026

The day begins with breakfast at CTU, an exploration of environmental and resource concerns that call us to a deeper responsibility for caring for the earth, followed by a conversation about a farm project in Chicago. We then travel to the Precious Blood Ministry of Reconciliation for lunch and a session with Fr. Dave Kelly about restorative justice, hope, and radical hospitality. The visit includes a tour of the facilities and time with staff and program participants. We return to CTU for dinner, shared reflection, and closing prayer.

Thursday, March 26, 2026

The day begins with breakfast and Mass at CTU, followed by a panel presentation inviting us to explore the lived experiences and concerns of our LGBTQ+ brothers and sisters. After lunch, we travel to the well-known Center on Halsted, a place of welcome and advocacy that has supported LGBTQ+ health, wellness, and other cultural enrichment since 1973.

We return to CTU for our last evening together to close our time with ritual and joyful celebration, sharing a festive dinner that honors the relationships formed and the experiences that have shaped us throughout our time together.
